11. Sheriff's Department Update by Deputy White: crime report given
12. Fire Department-Disaster Services: What kind of help we can get in an emergency. Captain Keith Rummler presented a video to the community; CERT presentation by Mr. Tom Fisher on program capabilities and training; hand radio use and benefit during an emergency
13. Deputy Supervisor Norm Hickling: Workshop meeting on Flood Plain Management update; issued congratulations on behalf of Supervisor for having a full council. Community member noted placement of private fences on water right of ways designed to prevent flooding/concerned fences will affect safety of community during flooding. Kara Kerr asked Norm Hickling if water right of ways are formalized in an easement on local property owners.

14. Committee Reports:

- a.) Public Information: Report by Vladimir Gomez: noted that Council will keep same website with GoDaddy; and would like to add features that will show resources available
- b.) Planning Committee Report by Committee Chair Kara Kerr attached and incorporated by reference herein. Noted Park Board expressing jurisdiction over community garden issue. We have a spot bill AB 262 for our sexually violent predator law. Kara Kerr introduced Brittani Daniels from Assembly Lackey's Office discussed in more detail the status of the sexually violent predator legislation. Ms. Daniels also mentioned AB46 and making it a felony for possession of date rape drugs.
- c.) Community Standards District: no new information
- d.) Election: Lee Crawford mentions need for appointing a person to Chair this committee

15. Meeting Reports:

- a.) ARTC report by Lee Crawford (record at 1 hr. 40 min): response by ARTC regarding renewable energy ordinance (issues mentioned in the meeting: site disturbance, valley fever, water supply to maintain sites, impacts on wild life including movement corridors); Kara Kerr spoke at ARTC on placement of sexually violent predators and requested support from neighboring communities. Five other town councils have approved support and drafted letters of support for legislation regarding placement of sexually violent predators; submitting said letters to Assemblyman Tom Lackey's office.
- b.) Illegal Dumping Report: Richard Johnson reported \$ 9.00 fee increase; mattresses not accepted. Lee Crawford mentioned free dumping day through waste management.

16. Community Announcements:

- a.) Lake LA Park Association: Mary Hanna announced Carnival being held at the park; closure of the gym; county had to replace copper wire that was stolen so that lights can be up before Carnival; East Gate has been enlarged
- b.) Park Supervisor Regina: color fun run promotion and status; promoted County Capers and Baking Class activities for children;
- c.) Park Association: Mary Hanna Fourth of July still wanting support from Council on Parade
- d.) Library Association: participating in Carnival and shared activities for the upcoming month.
- e.) Old Bald Guys: April 25th on Saturday. Community member John Crawford willing to volunteer truck for pick up.
