

Planning Meeting November 6, 2013

Meeting called to order at 7:00pm

Location: Stephen Sorensen County Park

Council members present: Kristi Kennedy, Bob Horsewood, Robin Nute and Mary Anne Brouillard.

10 community members and 2 law enforcement officers present.

A) Kristi Kennedy gave a brief summation of the Christopher Evan Hubbard situation.

Property owner has canceled his contract. As for now Mr. Hubbard will not be moving into this location. A new home must be researched to house Mr. Hubbard. A new location will be chosen and the public will be notified of a public hearing.

The public spoke out about their concerns regarding Mr. Hubbard. In general the public is opposed to Mr. Hubbard being in our community. Mr. Hubbard is known as the pillow case rapist. He has admitted to breaking into homes and assaulting 40 women in the Los Angeles and San Francisco Bay area.

- A concerned community member asked about the home located on Stagecoach. She expressed her concern was that Sex offenders would be moved into this home. She wanted to know how this could be stopped.
- There was discussion about a registered sex offender that is suppose to be living on 164th Street but is not living at that location. The community would like to know where he is.
Kristi Kennedy recommended that the community research Maegans Law and the District Attorneys website.

The community would like us to write a letter to the court Judge Brown asking how sex offenders are monitored. What safeguards do they have in place? How can we stop future parolees and sex offenders from being released into our community?

Questions were asked about our Police Sub-Station *not* being manned. Kristi Kennedy asked if the community wanted to have the station manned at the expense of losing officers on the streets. The deputies spoke about how paroles are monitored. They explained that sex offenders are not subject to search. Deep checks are most often done on current paroles.

B) The community would like us to write a letter to the District Attorney asking how registered sex offenders are monitored.

Discussion as to whether or not the election committee needs to make a report.
General consensus is no as there will be no election.

Town council business is discussed. Up coming agenda for November 26th meeting.
